

01/03/24- DODDINGTON GROVE GARDENING UPDATE



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£5,000 Award from Southwark Council's, Cleaner, Greener, Safer (CGS) Funding

-£4,000 plant beds, solar lights & wire border. £1,000 Tools & equipment.

-Estate divided into 5 areas. Important all residents benefit from funding.

5 AREAS: Originally £800 per area. **Adjusted for practicality to, £114 per plant bed** (32 x 114 = £3,648), £352 for 3 x solar lights and wire border to each plant bed.

Total of 32 plant beds:

-Plants sourced locally from, the Walworth Garden. Larger central plant/s, evergreens that flower, surrounded by cheaper perennials/evergreens.

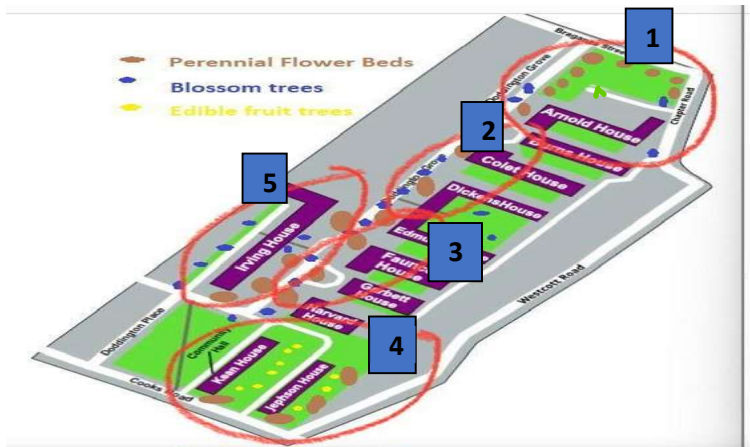
